



Cancellation Policy for Live and Online Trainings

Due to the nature of these courses there is necessary preparation time and costs; therefore, we cannot provide refunds after a certain point.

Please carefully read this cancellation policy before signing up for a course.

- A. **All deposits are nonrefundable*** upon being accepted into a course. If an applicant is not accepted into a course, the deposit will be returned to them through the means by which they paid, minus any bank fees.
**Due to the unpredictable nature of our current world situation, if a student needs to cancel their participation or if a training is cancelled due to government restrictions, all students will be allowed to transfer their deposit to another Sacred Heart Yoga training, retreat, workshop or other offering, to be used within two years of the initial training start date.*
- B. **In advance of 14 days before the course start date**, a student wishing to cancel their participation will receive a full refund minus the deposit. The deposit may be used towards another Sacred Heart Yoga training, retreat, workshop or other offering, to be used within two years of the initial training start date.
- C. **Between 1 and 14 days prior to the course start date**, a student wishing to cancel their participation will receive a refund of 50% of the fees paid. The remaining 50% can be put towards another Sacred Heart Yoga training, retreat, workshop, or other paid offering, to be used within two years of the initial training start date.
- D. **A participant wishing to withdraw from a course, or who is asked to withdraw by the faculty after the start date and up to one-quarter of the program length** will receive a 25% refund, only.
- E. **A participant wishing to withdraw from a course, or who is asked to withdraw by the faculty after one-quarter of the program has passed** will not receive any refund.
- F. **There are no refunds for pre-recorded trainings.**
